"Back to School" Information

Morning Drop-Off

We are allowing families to walk their students for morning drop-off to class on Friday, August 10th and Monday, August 13th. Please park at Jim Jeffers Park if you wish to do this, but be mindful of our detour traffic pattern. Beginning Tuesday, August 14th, families must use the assigned morning drop off procedure. **Please see attached map for detour procedures.**

Afternoon Drop-Off

Siblings of afternoon VPK and Kindergarten students will follow the front carline procedure. These students will meet their younger sibling in the Kindergarten hallway of the school building. Families of afternoon VPK and Kindergarten students have received a PINK (VPK or Kindergarten) carline card and a GREEN (1st-5th grade) carline card. Please show the PINK carline card as this card determines the detour carline you will follow. There is a sign that states "VPK LINE STOP" that is located at the front entrance of the school, via Jim Jeffers Park. Please stop at this sign until a staff member starts carline. It is imperative that you follow the arrows located on the pavement in the Jim Jeffers Park parking lot in order to avoid any mishaps. School buses will also be using this route, so please be aware and use caution. Please see attached map for detour procedures.

For families that <u>only</u> have 1st-5th grade students (GREEN card), you will follow the normal back carline procedure. **Please see attached map for detour procedures.**

Students are <u>not</u> permitted to walk home during afternoon dismissal unless they live in the immediate vicinity of the school. To become a "walker," families must contact the school to get approval by the principal, Mr. Brown. The home address of each student will be verified by the school. Please keep the construction around our school in mind when determining if your student will be a walker.

With all the construction around our school, we ask that everyone please display patience and understanding concerning the situation that we <u>all</u> are experiencing. Safety for all stakeholders (students, staff, parents, etc.) is our number one priority.
