What is the School Advisory Council (SAC)?

SAC is a group intended to represent the school community (i.e. Parents, Students, Local Business, etc.) and those persons who share the responsibility for guiding the school towards continuous improvement (i.e. Teachers, Administrators, etc.)

What is the role of the SAC?

The role of the SAC is to develop and implement the School Improvement Plan, which includes education goals and strategies for improvement. These goals and strategies are based upon measurements of student progress. In addition, at Christa McAuliffe, the SAC also works to initiate activities and programs that strengthen the community within the school.

What is a SAC member's role?

The SAC Member:

- Functions as a council member according to established procedures by making suggestions and recommendations representative of their constituents' views.
- Participates regularly in SAC meetings and carries out council assignments.
- Becomes knowledgeable about the resources of the school, community and the school's educational program.
- Serves as a communications link between the SAC, their constituent groups, the community and the school.
- Acts as a resource person for the SAC by making available specialized information:
 1. Assists in identifying resources
 2. Accepts assigned responsibilities for assisting in and coordinating the implementation of new programs.
