ReadingPals help build a strong foundation for literacy and a love of reading. By giving just a small amount of time, they help children develop the skills and enthusiasm for reading, which is so critical to academic success.

ReadingPals is a literacy program operated by United Way of Lee, Hendry, Glades and Okeechobee. Why does United Way care about helping children learn to read? **Because children who read at grade level by the fourth grade are four times more likely to graduate from high school.** And children who graduate from high school are more likely to be successful, productive community members.

**United Way is looking for parent, high school, and college student volunteers to read to 1st graders at CME.** The volunteers not only enjoy helping children discover a love of reading, they become their “Pals”. They spend an hour each week during the school year talking, drawing, reading and building a relationship with one another. **For some, this relationship is life-changing.**
